

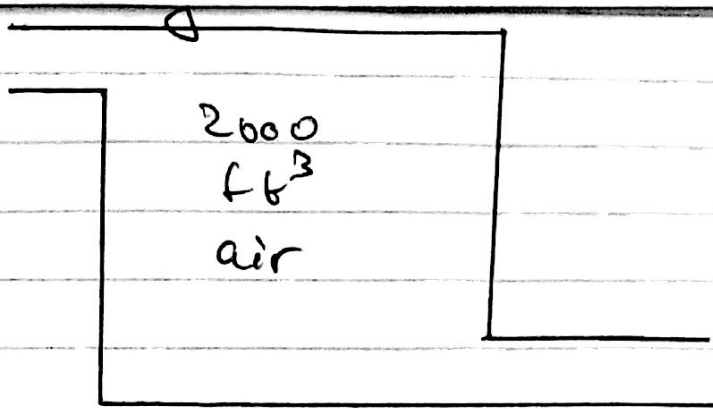

600 ft³/min



$$\frac{dy}{dt} = y_{in} - y_{out}$$

$$y_{in} = 600$$

$$y_{out} = \frac{600}{20000} = 0.03y$$

$$\frac{dy}{dt} = 600 - 0.03y$$

$$\frac{dy}{dt} = -0.03(y - 20000)$$

$$\int \frac{dy}{(y - 20000)} = \int -0.03 dt$$

$$\ln(y - 20000) = -0.03t + C$$

$$y - 20000 = e^{-0.03t + C}$$

$$y - 20000 = y_0 \cdot e^{-0.03t}$$

$$y = y_0 e^{-0.03t} + 20000$$

a) At $t = 0$, $y = 0$

$$y = y_0 e^{-0.03t} + 20000$$
$$0 = y_0 e^{-0.03(0)} + 20000$$

$$\therefore y_0 = -20000$$

$$y = -20000 e^{-0.03t} + 20000$$

b) 90% of 20000 = 18000 (mode)

$$y = 18000$$

$$18000 = -20000 e^{-0.03t} + 20000$$
