1 PATENT

A patent is a form of intellectual property that makes the owner have legal right to exclude others from making, using, selling and importing an invention for a limited period of years in exchange for publishing and enabling public disclosure of invention.

2 COPY RIGHT

Copy right is the exclusive right given to the creator of a creative work to ~~produce~~ reproduce the work usually for a limited time. The creative work may be in literary, artistic education or musical form. This means that the organization or the original creator of the products and any one they give authorization are the only ones with exclusive right to reproduce the work.

3 TRADE MARK

A Trade mark is a type of intellectual property consisting of a recognizable sign, design, or expression which identifies products or services of a particular source from those of others, although trademark used to identify services are usually called service marks.

4 TRADE SECRET

A trade secret is information that is not generally known to the public, confer economic benefit on its holder because the information is not publicly known and where the holder makes reasonable effort to maintain its secrecy.
