

Where water is not available, ensure you clean hard surfaces in your homes because the virus also settles on surfaces and can be contracted if a person touches the infected surface and put his/her fingers into the eyes, nostrils or mouth. Also, avoid touching your face [most especially the eyes, nostrils and mouth]. Sneeze and cough into your elbow or better still use a tissue and dispose properly. CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19)

Coronavirus disease is an infectious disease caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus. It was discovered in Wuhan Province, China in the year 2019. The disease causes respiratory illness with symptoms such as a cough, fever and in more severe cases, difficulty breathing. It is primarily spread through direct contact or being it at least 1 metre distance with an infected person.

Ever since the identification of this virus, it has spread across many regions of the globe resulting in to pandemic. Many lives has been lost and this pandemic has caused partial or total lockdown across many countries. Great and most developed countries have been brought to their knees due to the pandemic. For instance, United States of America, the biggest infected country in the world with about 545,086 active cases, 27,176 deceased and 47,009 recovered; Italy, 105,418 active, 21,645 deceased and 38,092 recovered; Russia, 22,306 active, 198 deceased, 1,986 recovered; Japan, 7,101 active, 146 deceased and 853 recovered. Globally, we have 1,401,549 active cases.

Corona came into Nigeria 28th February, 2020. The first hit state was Lagos state. Nigeria presently has 163 active cases, 11 deceased and 99 recovered. This pandemic has also caused a partial nation in Nigeria which will be discussed later.

Though, no vaccine has been discovered yet, there are measures which can be following to prevent the virus from entering into the body system. These include; Washing your hands thoroughly for about 40 seconds under running water, Use an alcohol based Sanitizer after washing your hands or in cases
