How Corona Virus Came about. Corona Virus which is well known to be COVID-19, was emerged in Wuhan, China on December 31, 2019. Corona virus belongs to the Coronaviridae family in the Picornavirales order. At the end of 2019, when an emerging illness - flu of China - experienced an outbreak of this disease. Corona virus that killed more than eighteen hundred and infected over seventy thousand individuals within the fifty days of epidemic. Anybody with this pandemic shows symptoms five days but would range from two-to-forteen days. The symptoms are, diarrhea, Cough, Shortness of breath, fever and loss of smell. The virus can be easily spread when an infected person is in close contact with a non-infected person it begins. CORONAVIRUS IN NIGERIA

The NCDC (National Center for Disease Control)

This government agency is in charge of the Coordination and Surveillance, detection and response of Infectious Diseases and helping to control Outbreak. Over the last three years NCDC has deployed a new tool for disease surveillance. The Surveillance, Outbreak response management and analysis System (SOFRMIS) is a system of jointly developed between NCDC and the C.I.H.E.M.B.O.C (Centre of infection). So far so good NCDC has supported States to improve coordination of outbreak preparedness and response. NCDC is located in Ogun, Lagos, Oyo, Abuja, Sokoto, Kaduna etc.
