FORMS OF WRITING

There are four (4) types of writing; which are expository, narrative and descriptive.

EXPOSITORY WRITING

This means writing in which the authors purpose is to inform or explain the subject to the reader.

PERSUASIVE WRITING

This means writing in which it will state the opinion of the writer and attempt to influence the reader.

NARRATIVE WRITING

This means writing in which the author tells a story. The story could be either fact or fiction.

DESCRIPTIVE WRITING

A type of expository writing that uses the five senses to paint a picture to the reader. This writing incorporate imagery and specific details.
