Nigeria's Response to corona virus - Disease outbreak in Africa's most populous country is never taken lightly and with the gravity of the global situation of covid-19 pandemic, The Nigerian Government had to over post and mobilize all resources for the outbreak response.

Once the outbreak, the Nigerian Ministry of Health activated Emergency operation centres (EOCs) in all of the affected states to coordinate outbreak response activities. The EOC, which is a model first introduced by the polio programmes. The NEDC has developed a new tool for case surveillance. NEDC is located in Osun, Lagos, Digo, Abuja, Rivers, Kano and Plateau.
