i) Physical environment

iii) Social environment

i) PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT;

This is a type of human environment that includes purely physical factors. Also considered as the non living things.

Examples are;

Water, air, soil, housing, waste, radiation, climate.

ii) BIOLOGICAL ENVIRONMENT;

This are referred to as the living organisms and are often referred as the biotic factors.

Examples are;

Plants and animal life including bacteria, viruses, insects, rodents and animals.

iii) SOCIAL ENVIRONMENT;

This refers to the immediate physical and social setting in which people live or in which something happens or develops.

Examples are;

Customs ,culture and beliefs,habits, income, occupation, religious practices.
