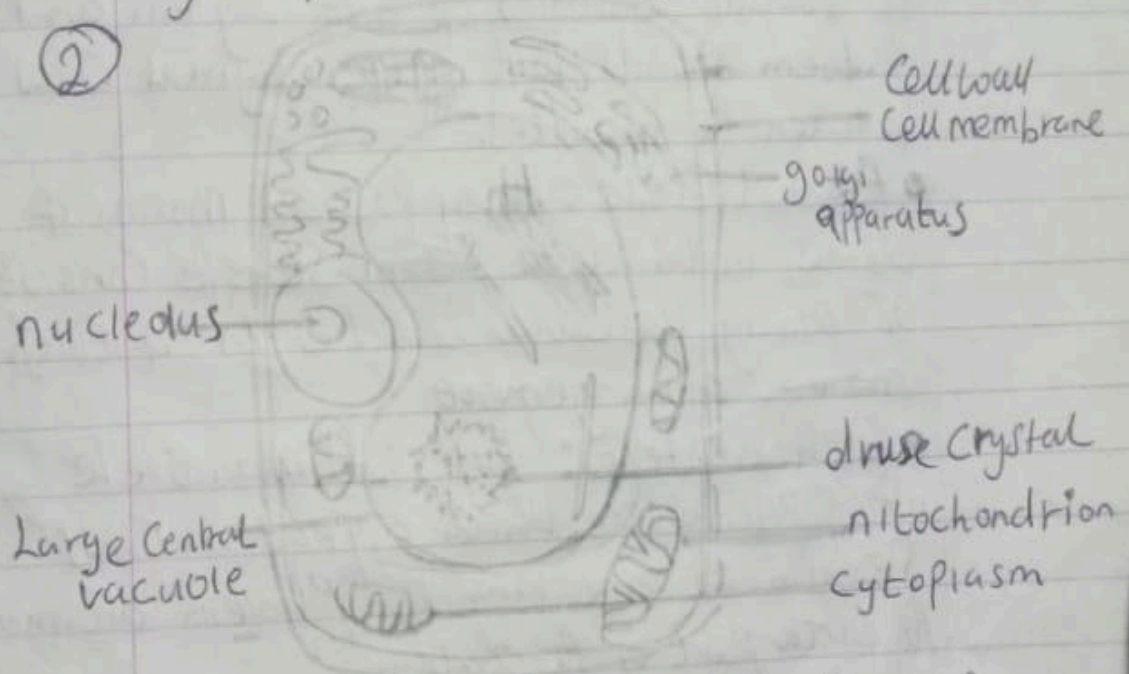

③ The Sexual reproduction consist of three sequential stages which are: Plasmogamy, Karyogamy, and meiosis.

④ Bryophytes adapt in their environment by a waxy cuticle gametangia, this helps to protect the plant tissue from drying out

⑤ • Eusteles: dicotyledonous plant that consist of vascular bundles of both xylem and phloem strands with parenchymal cells between the bundles.

• Aeactostele: they possess monocot stems, in which the stem stele consist of many vascular bundles in a confusing ~~number~~ arrangement

• Siphonostele: This is a monostele type of siphonostele which appears in cross section as one ring of phloem around the outer part of the xylem
