Discuss the disease of renal system

Renal system disease, any of the diseases or disorders that affect the human urinary system. They include benign and malignant tumours, infections and inflammations, and obstruction by calculi. organs of the renal system.

Causes

Common causes of urinary disorders include:

- Benign prostatic hyperplasia (enlargement of the prostate)
- Cancers or benign tumors.
- Dehydration.
- Infections of the urinary tract.
- Interstitial cystitis
 (conditions involving chronic inflammation of the bladder)
- Kidney diseases.
- Kidney or urinary tract stones.

Common symptoms of urinary disorders include abdominal, pelvic, or lower back pain or discomfort; blood in the urine; changes in the urine; difficulty producing urine; fever and chills; frequent urination; leaking of urine; and urgent need to urinate.

Prevention

Urinate frequently. This flushes bacteria out of the bladder and may reduce the risk of cystitis in those who are prone to urinary tract infections. ...

Avoid fluids and foods that irritate the bladder, such as alcohol, citrus juices, drinks containing caffeine and spicy foods. Also avoid smoking

during this time.
