> 1. Attempt an incisive interrogation of Solomon .A. Edebor Good Morning, Sodom underscoring at least five underlying thematic thrusts the drama engages.

1. Theme of Love: The story revolves around Demola and Keziah, who are classmates. Demola expresses his feelings from Keziah, but she isn't interested. Demola becomes more desperate for Keziah's attention, leading him to resort to extreme measures.

2. Theme of Betrayal: Demola betrays Keziah by drugging her and sexually assaulting her. Additionally, Keziah's parents are disappointed in her for getting pregnant while in school, thinking she wasn't focused enough on her studies.

3. Theme of Cultism: Demola becomes a member of the Red Shadows confraternity, a cult group led by Nkanga Nwolo (aka "k.k") and other member, including "Spark," "Bentol," and "Jumo." Demola is introduced to drugs and commits offenses at their urging, including spiking Keziah's drink and taking advantage of her.

4. Theme of Forgiveness: Keziah's father, "Dr. Aworawo Richards, initially condemns Keziah for her pregnancy and refuses t believe her when she tells the truth. However, when the truth comes out, he begs for her forgiveness, and Keziah pleads with her parents to forgive her for tarnishing their image.

5. Theme of Violence: The Red Shadows and the Sparrows engage in a fight that results in the deaths of Dagren and Festula. In revenge, the Red Shadows plot to kill the Sparrows, resulting in sporadic shootings that lead to Demola's death and injuries to k.k. and others.

- KEZIAH
