It is, however, pertinent to remind students of a few guidelines for resumption.

1. **Students' registration exercise shall be from 8am to 7pm and students are advised to avoid night journey for security reasons.**
2. Students are not allowed to have more than two bags and a laptop bag. The first may contain their personal effects, while the second may be for their provisions. Each should not weigh more than 30Kg, with a total weight of **60kg only**.
3. Students should note the importance of compliance with wearing the Senate approved dress code and colours for their college. Students are requested to bring along dresses in line with the Senate directives. For the avoidance of doubt, the expected colour approved for each college is stated below:

4. Afe Babalola University places strong emphasis on decent dressing and as such dresses to be worn to colleges during lecture hours and indeed around the campus should be decent.
5. Coloured hair is not allowed for females, the length of hair should be moderate and the hair styles should be modest. **Fake eye lashes and artificial finger nails are not allowed.**
6. Male students must have decent hairstyles and shall shave clean their beards at all times.
7. All kinds of illicit drugs are **strictly prohibited**. Parents are hereby requested to carefully check their wards bags before such bags are used for packing. Students found with drugs will **attract outright expulsion**.
8. Students with health conditions and on medications must declare their status and present the drugs to the Chief Medical Director, ABUAD Multisystem Hospital for verification.

Food, drinking and cooking systems: · Alcoholic Drinks · Noodles · Raw Food Items · Cooking Utensils

Prohibited drugs: · All Illicit Drugs including · Cigarettes · Alcoholic Beverages · Shisha pot · Shisha pen

Others: Knives · Forks · Dagger · Cutlass (Except for Agricultural Science Students) · Firearms of any kind, etc. Binoculars · Fireworks · Siren · Lethal Weapons & Injections · Hurley Bubbly · Kerosene Lamps · Candles, Matches and Gas Lighter · Face Masks and all forms of camouflages materials.
